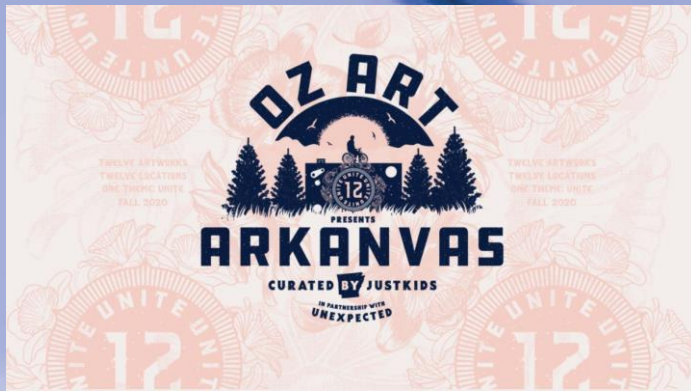
## CLA Show Opportunities:

UCA Outreach & Community Engagement has invited us to use their gallery space to display a holiday show!

The show will run from November 5<sup>th</sup> - December 15<sup>th</sup> and would be located in the gallery space at UCA Downtown on Oak Street. Artwork should be holiday or winter themed although we can accept other subjects. To participate, you must be current on your CLA dues. Each artist can bring up to two artworks. We can accept a total of 5 pottery and 3-D works because there are 5 podiums available. No sawtooth hangers will be accepted. Size restrictions should be close to the size res. of the Fall Show of 41 inches.
